Specific Department Rules

1. All General, Family Living and other Rules and Regulations apply.
2. Work must be matted or framed and be ready to hang.
3. Entries must have been completed within the past 2 years and a date and name clearly visible on it.
4. All works will be labeled with a form "NAME, TITLE, DATE, MEDIA, & SUBJECT WORK MATTER", available at the time of entry.
5. All entries will be marked to show they have been entered in the Greene County Fair.
6. Each class may include work done in any media listed below.
7. No class work will be accepted. (Class work recognizable by many entries of same print.)
8. Media: Oil, Acrylic, Water Color, Pastel, Charcoal, Pen, Mosaics and Abstract

2. All Christmas Exhibits will be entered in this department.
3. Due to space, hanging articles cannot be larger than 24 inches and must be hangable.

Food Preparation

Specific Department Rules

1. All General, Family Living and other Rules and Regulations apply.
2. Products using honey and also diabetic entries must attach recipe.
3. Honey products must be at least ½ honey as the sweetening agent.
4. All products must be made from scratch.
5. Limit Non-Decorated cakes to only ½ of the cake, due to no refrigeration.
6. Decorated cakes, no larger than 9" x 13" pan or 9 inch circle.
7. Entries in Decorated Cake Lots do not have to be a cake, it can be either cake, Styrofoam, or box.

Department FP – Food Preparation

Food Preservation Department

Specific Department Rules

1. All General, Family Living and other Rules and Regulations apply.
2. All exhibits in Food Preservation **MUST** be in standard ½ pint, pint, and quart jars of clear glass, such as Kerr or Ball. No peanut butter jars, etc. will be acceptable. Ball & Kerr have special Food Preservation Awards.
3. Jars and lids should be clean, sealed and polished.
4. Prior to entering, labels should be put on the plain side of jar opposite the manufacturer's name.
5. Headspace requirements are:
 - 1" for all vegetables, canned in the pressure canner (everything but tomatoes);
 - ½ " for all fruits, tomatoes, pickles, relishes, juices, and other products canned in a hot water bath canner;
 - ¼ " for all sweet spreads which includes jams, jellies, butters, preserves, and marmalades.

Flower Department

Specific Department Rules

1. Entry MUST be grown by the exhibitor.
2. Exhibitor MUST furnish a clear plastic soda bottle container.
3. Stems should be long enough for at least 2 leaves to show above the neck of the bottle.
4. Only ONE specimen per container.
5. Potted plants must only have ONE variety per container.
6. The Superintendent or Fair Officials are not responsible for loss or breakage of containers or accessories.
7. Artificial flowers and foliage are not permitted in any lot.
8. All fresh flowers or dried plant material used should be yard or home grown.
9. Entries in the Artistic Flower shows must be completely arranged before they are brought into the building.

1. All General, Family Living and other Rules and Regulations apply.
2. Work must be matted with a stiff backing and ready to hang. **(NO GLASS FRAMES MAY BE USED)**
3. Minimum size is 5" x 7".
4. Homemade mats are acceptable.
5. All entries must be photographed by the exhibitor since August of the previous year.
6. An entry will consist of: photo; exhibitors name; department, class and lot in which the photo is to be judged.
7. Digital photography can only be used in the Digital Classes and Lots.

4-H Big Pumpkin & Big Watermelon Contest

4. Pre-registration is due in the Greene County Extension Office when Seeds are picked up.
5. The Greene County weigh-in will be at the time of entry.
6. Pumpkins and watermelons that are damaged due to rots, punctures, etc. will not be eligible for weigh-in. The criteria for conducting the weigh-in will be the actual weight of quality watermelons or pumpkins.
